

Andy Goldsworthy

Retour sur un travail solitaire

14 juillet au 24 décembre 2023

In 1994, curator Nadine Gomez invited British artist Andy Goldsworthy to present an exhibition in tribute to the diversity of life.

Since then, the sculptor has definitively entered the history of Haute-Provence landscapes. He created a series of permanent works in abandoned villages around Digne: Refuge d'Art.

With its famous clay wall, the Gassendi Museum contains the first Refuge d'Art. It was created in 1999 by Andy Goldsworthy at the request of choreographer Régine Chopinot for La danse du temps. Created in situ in the landscapes room, this work draws the cracked meanders of a river and offers an ever-relevant vision of our relationship to nature and to the Earth.

"Behind this wall there is a magnificent view of the surrounding landscape. I didn't hide this view but I discovered it inside the building and I also hope somehow inside of ourselves." (Andy Goldsworthy)

The current exhibition takes place in the same room - renovated for the occasion following the reinstallation of important landscape paintings, which had been removed from the light for preservation reasons.

Other works by Andy Goldsworthy, created in and around Digne from 1995 to 2015, are exhibited in conversation with River of earth and surround the more monumental Refuge d'Art work.

This is the first time that these works - sculptures, personal forms - have been shown in a solo exhibition.

Through photography and video, essential for keeping a trace of his ephemeral creations, the artist reveals his work process in his "southern laboratory," as he likes to name the Digne region.

Traces of clay on canvases constitute another attempt to preserve the permanence of gestures in matter.

"Mortality and instability are always present in his mind," as the philosopher Donna Haraway said.

Drawings of *Refuge d'Art* projects that have been imagined but not carried out were recently donated by the artist, completing the Gassendi Museum's collection – the largest collection of Andy Goldsworthy works in the world.
